ADMISSION PROCEDURE

JUNIOR COLLEGE

As per the directives of Government of Maharashtra ADMISSIONS to class XI are "ONLINE" since 2009. Eligible student is required to register himself / herself for ONLINE admission. Government authorities allot the college to students. Once the college is allotted student is required to take admission within three days in the allotted college. If student fails he/she will be thrown out of admission process. Other details of admission are given in the booklet issued by Government oi Maharashtra.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Any student who has passed the S.S.C. (Std. X) examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the Board is eligible for admission to the F.Y.J.C. (Std. XI) class.
- 2. A student who has passed an examination other than that conducted by the Maharashtra State Board will be admitted provisionally by the College. However, such students will have to obtain an 'Eligibility Certificate' from the Divisional Secretary, Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary, Mumbai and submit to the College. Documents to be submitted along with application for admission are as under:
- a) Original Mark Sheet along with two attested xerox copies of the qualifying examination.
- b) Original School Leaving Certificate with two attested xerox copy.



- Original Caste Certificate along with one attested xerox copy if admission is being sought against particular category.
- Original copies of necessary proof along with one xerox copy in case of any other reserved category such as freedom fighters, Govt. job transfers, ex-serviceman, handicapped etc.
- 5. Students belonging to reserve category and are seeking admission must produce scholarship form along with caste certificate issued by the competent authority of the Govt. of Maharashtra, failing which, their claim for admission will not be entertained under the specified category. In case of the student migrating from other States / Boards-claiming admission they will be given only if they submit Caste Validating Certificate from the Competent Authority of Maharashtra State.

Note: 1) All admissions are provisional until confirmed by the appropriate authorities.

- Admissions can be cancelled only after due submission of prescribed application forms, available in the office.
- Fees will be refunded as per rules.
- 4) All admissions are valid only for one academic year, subject to satisfactory attendance and separate application is required to be submitted by a student for each subsequent year of enrolment.
- Students are advised to keep xerox copies of Mark Sheet and Leaving Certificate. Original Mark sheet will be returned only after verification, confirmation of admission.


